Zionism and Egyptian Nationalism: The De Menasce, Mosseri,

This work studies the Jewish community in the 1940s Egypt, in a period of rising Zionism in Erets-Israel and in parts of the Jewish Egyptian community. I focus on the main families, who led the community, and on the main factors of tension among the community members. The analysis mainly deals with the complicated relationships between the deferent groups who comprised the Jewish Egyptian community, and their feelings towards the concepts of Zionism, Egyptian nationalism and socialism. I also discuss the implications of the then common various Jewish immigration had on this community.
